





Trial Status 2020/21: AHDB Recommended

Acacia is the highest yielding variety available on the AHDB Recommended List 2020/21, setting a new benchmark for oilseed rape performance in the UK. The open pollinated variety is an Anastasia cross, inheriting strong autumn and spring vigour, solid disease resistance and short, stiff straw, combined with high oil content.



Acacia has shown extremely high gross output and treated yield potential in both England and Scotland, showing the variety performs well across the whole of the UK.






Trial Status 2020/21: AHDB Recommended





Acacia is a short variety with very stiff stems and very good lodging resistance, providing growers with an easier, quicker harvest.

Acacia produces high levels of oil. Oil quality bonuses and premiums are increasingly important and oil content genetics are very stable, providing a way of safeguarding income.
