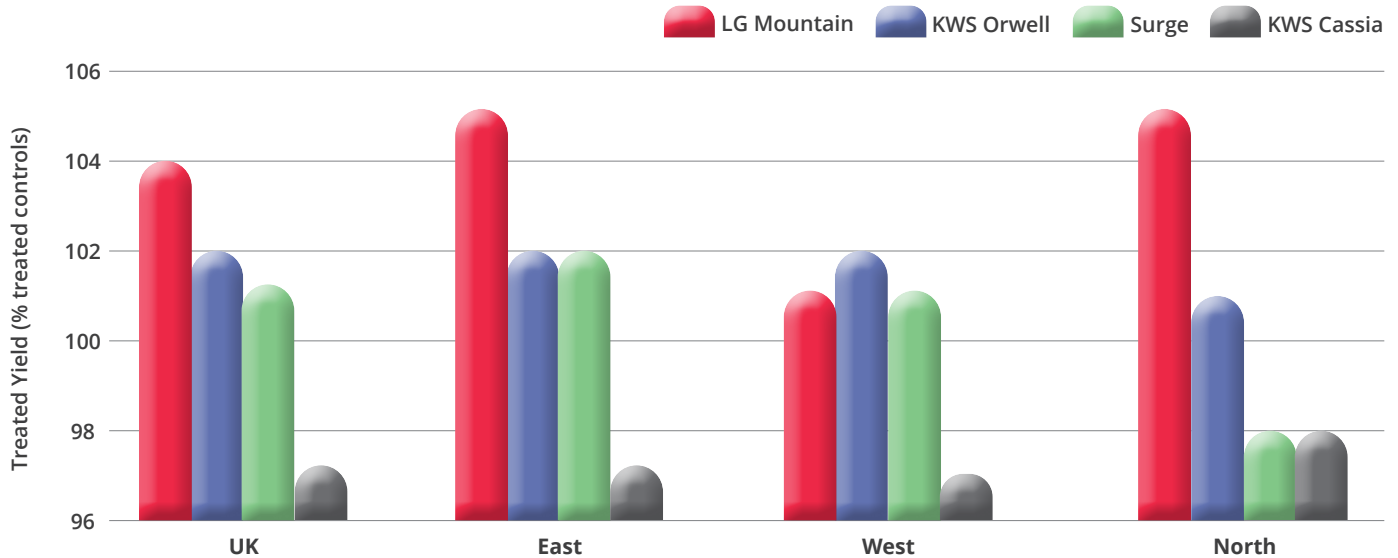

LG Mountain is one of the highest yielding 2-row winter feed barley varieties available. The variety performs consistently across all regions, combined with good agronomic characteristics of short straw, great disease resistance and good grain quality.

LG Mountain offers a significant step forward in yield for 2-row barley varieties, over other commercial varieties on the AHDB RL 2020/21.



LG Mountain has consistently shown very high yield potential over seasons and regions, in both treated and untreated trials.
