




Pediaree: Harlequin x KWS Glacier

Trial Status 2020/21: UK Recommendation

LG Mountain is one of the highest yielding 2-row winter feed barley varieties available. The variety performs consistently across all regions, combined with good agronomic characteristics of short straw, great disease resistance and good grain quality.





LG Mountain has consistently shown very high yield potential over seasons and regions, in both treated and untreated trials.

LG Mountain is a short strawed variety, showing good lodging resistance with standard PGR applications.

LG Mountain is earlier maturing at -1.

LG Mountain has a good all-round disease profile, including BaYMV resistance.

LG Mountain has good grain quality attributes with a very good specific weight; an important feature in a 2-row winter barley.
